

**Programs for Students with Disabilities
Special Education and Section 504**

IDEIA, the Individuals with disabilities Education Improvement Act, is a special Education Law that provides assurances to handicapped students that they are entitled to a Free Appropriate Public Education.

Section 504, The Rehabilitation Act of 1973, is a nondiscrimination statute enacted by the United States Congress. The purpose of the Act is to prohibit discrimination and to assure that disabled students have educational opportunities and benefits equal to those provided to non-disabled students.
